




Silhouette rhinestones

1



Select a rhinestone template. Do NOT resize it. Feed the template material into the Silhouette without a cutting mat. Use the pink cap and a thickness of 28-33 when cutting the design.


Peel the template material off the backing leaving the circle cutouts behind. It works best to peel the material off in one quick motion.


Affix the template material to a rhinestone backing board.

Gently brush rhinestones into the template holes using the brush provided.

5



Once all of the rhinestons are positioned face-up in the template, cover the design with a piece of rhinestone transfer tape.

6



Lift the rhinestones (now attached to the transfer tape) off the template and position the design on the desired surface.

7



Place a cloth over the design and press down on top with a heated iron for 45-60 seconds. The iron should be set to the "wool" setting.

8



Remove iron, cloth and transfer tape. If rhinestones continue to stick to the transfer tape, replace cloth and iron again at a hotter setting.

9



Turn the garment inside out and repeat step 7. This will pull the glue into the fabric.

Your new rhinestone design will be the envy of all your friends!



Wash and dry clothes inside out. Only use designs marked as rhinestone templates.

Use extreme caution when operating a hot iron. Keep out of reach of children.
